PURPOSE

Antioch Community Church Dallas has been fortunate. We have not had a major crisis or emergency to date that was not handled expeditiously. However, moving forward, there is a need for greater safety measures to ensure that potential threats or hazards do not disrupt the flow of ministry or threaten the lives of those in our community. Our first line of defense is God and his covering. Amen! Believing that safety is unnecessary, however, is an error and places the people who come into our facility at risk. An effectively trained safety team working with designated staff members helps ensure a proper response to a variety of scenarios.

- Blend in and be welcoming and friendly while also keeping watch.
- Always de-escalate situations with a calm but confident presence.

ROLE EXPECTATIONS

Scheduling	"Confirm or Decline" emailed service requests from planning center
Times	Arrives between 8:45am and 8:55am for our Serve Team Rally which begins at 9am.
Train	Participate (if available) in any future trainings/events that we have for the team.
Keep Watch	We serve through blending in, being friendly and welcoming, but also keeping watch over who is coming into our space and being aware of any suspicious persons or emergency situations and responding according to the procedures laid out in the Safety Team Manual. In this role, you'll keep watch over persons entering our facility and then during the service you'll sit somewhere where you have line of sight to entrances/exits and periodically patrol the facility.



Our <u>Safety Team Manual</u> is key to your success in serving. Know it well. Please review COMPLETELY before filling out an application.



TIME COMMITMENT

Safety Team members are asked to serve at least once per month and may serve up to every Sunday service. Commitment terms are 1 year from August to July (or from the start of your service date). You will have the opportunity to renew or decline serving at the end of each term.
