



## **TEAM: Lifegroups**

### **ROLE: Section Leader**

#### **PURPOSE**

Lifegroups are small group communities which meet house to house to walk with Jesus, become like Jesus, and help others follow Him. Modeled after Acts 2:42-47, Lifegroups are at the heart of who we are as a church community. Section Leaders oversee 2-4 Lifegroup Leaders to provide prayer, pastoral care, and discipleship.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

1. **Devotional Life** - values daily time w/ God; growing in relationship w/ God (Jo 15:1-5)
2. **Character**
  - a. Humble - puts the needs of others above themselves (Phi 2:3-4)
  - b. Hungry - growing devotion for Jesus; desires for others to follow Him (Ro 12:11)
  - c. Teachable - willing to say YES to Jesus even when it's stretching; desires to learn and receive instruction; works well on a team (Eph 4:2-3)
  - d. Above Reproach - lives with integrity; seeks to be above reproach as an example of Christ to others in and outside the church (1 Pt 5:3)
3. **Member** - is a member of Antioch Dallas (or plans to go through membership); regularly participates in Sunday service
4. **Experience** - Has shown ability to lead a Lifegroup effectively. Ideally, they experienced or led a Lifegroup multiplication process.

#### **ROLE EXPECTATIONS**

1. **Walk with Jesus**
  - a. Pray - regularly pray for the Lifegroup Leaders you're covering (Jo 15:1-5)
2. **Become like Jesus**
  - a. Disciple - invite leaders in your section to a monthly Leadership Group where the group will meet to gather in God's presence and build up one another.
  - b. Care - provide pastoral care to members in need and notify pastoral staff
3. **Help Others Follow Him**
  - a. Call Up - challenge and encourage the Lifegroup Leaders to call up others in their Lifegroup to take the next step in following Jesus. This way, the waterfall of 2 Timothy 2:2 is impacting all of the church.
